



Transport information for the Celebration of the Nativity of The Blessed Virgin Mary at Holy Trinity Tarleton

Stagecoach bus numbers 2 & 2A stop directly outside Preston railway station and give direct links to Tarleton operating every 30 minutes at 04 and 34 minutes past each hour with a journey time of 35 minutes.

Stagecoach bus number 2 gives direct links from Southport to Tarleton operating at hourly intervals from Southport Lord street the 10.16 departure for Southport arrives into Tarleton at 10.55

Stagecoach bus number 2A connects from the Merseyrail network at Ormskirk at hourly intervals. The 10.48 departure from Ormskirk would arrive at Tarleton at 11.20.

Important Notice. Arriva Trains Northern have announced Industrial Action for Saturday 8th September so there will be a very limited Northern rail service. Merseyrail Electrics will still however run a normal Saturday timetable between Liverpool Central and Ormskirk.

There is a train from **Blackpool South to Preston** at 09:49 via St Annes-On-The-Sea 10:00, Kirkham & Wesham 10:16 arriving into Preston 10:26. (THERE A NO CONNECTIONS FROM BLACKPOOL NORTH).

There is a special rail replacement bus from **Burnley Central** at 09:12 to Blackburn calling at Rose Grove 09:22 Accrington 09:29 Church & Oswaldtwistle 09:33 Rishton 09:45 giving an arrival into Blackburn of 09:55. With a connection to Preston at 10:09.

There is a train from **Blackburn** at 10:09 arriving into Preston at 10:26.

If traveling from Merseyside it is best to travel on the 09:47 Merseyrail electric service to Ormskirk stopping at all stations on route giving an arrival in Ormskirk of 10:24. Then proceed to Stand 6 at Ormskirk bus station for the 10:48 Stagecoach bus 2A service for Tarleton giving an arrival in Tarleton of 11:20.
