Heavenly Father, may we not be led astray in our own supposed cleverness, but grant us the humility to listen to the wisdom of Christ and follow him day by day.




O Lord Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy. Amen.


In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Hail Mary ~

He came to her and said, 'Hail, O favoured one! The Lord is with you.' (Lk 1:28)

She was deeply disturbed by these words and asked herself what this greeting could mean. (Lk 1:29)

Hail Mary ~

But the angel said to her, 'Mary, do not be afraid; you have found favour with God.' (Lk 1:30)

'Listen! You are to conceive and bear a son, and you must name him Jesus.' (Lk 1:31)

'The hungry he has filled with good things, the rich sent empty away.' (Lk 1:53)



He said: 'Lord now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word' (Lk 2:29)

Hail Mary ~

'For mine eyes have seen the salvation which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples.' (Lk 2:30-31)

Hail Mary ~

'A light to lighten the Gentiles and for glory to thy people Israel.' (Lk 2:32)

Hail Mary ~

Simeon said to Mary his mother, 'Behold this child is set for the fall and for the rising of many in Israel' (Lk 2:34)

Hail Mary ~

He is destined to be a sign that is rejected, and a sword will pierce your own soul also' (Lk 2:35)

And they went back to Nazareth, and the child grew to maturity, and he was filled with wisdom; and God's favour was with him. (Lk 2:39-40)
